



Fall Baseball

The Hendersonville Parks Department will once again be offering fall baseball leagues during 2017. Play will begin in mid-to-late August and will conclude by late October.

The fall program is for players 5-15 years old. Players will “play up” to their age next season (determined by age as of April 30, 2018). Players must be at least 5 and no older than 15 on April 30, 2018.

☞ Fall Leagues are a great experience, especially for players moving up to a new division. All rec divisions will follow Cal Ripken/Babe Ruth baseball rules with modifications. All OPEN divisions will follow USSSA/local option rules. *These are not sanctioned leagues and the parks department reserves the right to make local rule modifications as they see fit.*

Individual	6u: coach-pitch / t-ball option (recreational league)
Individual	8u: coach-pitch, 2 ¼” barrel bats only
Individual	10u: 46’ pitching, 60’ bases, no dropped 3rd strike, no lead off, 2 ¼” barrel bats only
Individual	12u: 50’ pitching, 70’ bases, leadoff, no Big Barrel Bats allowed
Individual	15u: 60’6” pitching, 90’ bases (No older than 15 on April 30, 2018)
Open Team	10u: 46’ pitching, 65’ bases, lead-off, dropped 3rd strike, Big Barrel bats are allowed (will not inter-league with REC teams)
Open Team	12u: 50’ pitching, 70’ bases, lead-off, Big Barrel bats are allowed
Open Team	14u: 60’6” pitching, 90’ bases (No older than 14 on April 30, 2018) (This division may inter-league with the 15u division – depends on total # of teams)

Individual Player Fees	\$ 80 (plus \$5 for all non residents)
Team Fees	\$ 625 (This covers all fees)

Parks Department will form teams from individual signups, and fee includes uniform (t-shirt and cap). Open teams are responsible for their own team, including uniforms (matching shirt in color is the only uniform requirement).

League will provide all game balls.

Registration Dates: **July 3rd – July 21st, M-F from 8-5**. All fees due at registration, payable to City of Hendersonville.
